

GRAND-A-WEEK LOTTERY 2011

The Grand-a-Week Lottery, a weekly fund-raising event sponsored by the Department of Orthopaedics, gives participants **52 chances to win \$1,000.00, tax free.** Lottery proceeds support orthopaedic research and education at Vancouver Acute. The 2011 Grand-a-Week Lottery will commence on **Monday, March 21, 2011.** *If you would like to participate, please fill out an application form as soon as possible. EVEN IF YOU PARTICIPATED IN THE 2010 LOTTERY, YOU MUST SIGN UP AGAIN.*

What is it? The Grand-a-Week Lottery is a weekly draw for \$1,000. A maximum of 400 tickets will be sold.

Who can play? The lottery is open to **all employees of VCH.** Ticket purchasers must be 19 years of age or older. **Non-VCH employees** may play but must pay \$260 in full by check made out to "VGH & UBC Hospital Foundation"

When? Draws take place every Monday or, if Monday is a statutory holiday, on the next working day.

What does it cost? \$5 per draw, or \$260 for the entire 52 weeks.

How are the winning numbers drawn? Three numbered balls are drawn randomly.

What are my chances of winning? Depending on the number of participants, there is at least a 1 in 400 chance of winning each week and, as your ticket number is entered in **every** draw, *YOU CAN WIN MORE THAN ONCE.*

How will I know if I win? The winners will be notified by telephone or email. This information will also be posted on the Department of Orthopaedics website (www.orthosurgery.ubc.ca/lottery.htm) and emailed to the participants.

When can I get my cheque? If your number is drawn, your cheque will be approximately 14 business days after the draw date.

Can I sign up for a few weeks at a time? No. The lottery is sold as a membership only. The minimum sign up period is 18 weeks.

What if I want to withdraw from the lottery? Participation in the lottery is for a minimum of 18 weeks. You may cancel after that time by providing a *written* cancellation with two weeks' notice.

What if I leave employment of the hospital or take an unpaid leave? You can either cancel your membership with *two weeks' notice* or remain in the lottery. If you have been paying by payroll deduction and wish to remain in the lottery, you must submit a cheque for the remaining draws.
